The Parish Council would like to publicise the procedure for reporting Defects, Fallen Trees, Branches and Potholes on the highway. Cumbria County Council is the highway authority. It maintains an excellent website for the purpose of reporting faults. The website is available on the link below, by searching [www.cumbria.gov.uk](http://www.cumbria.gov.uk) or from the Parish Council's site. Please do not report defects, Fallen Trees and Branches or Potholes to the Parish Council. Please contact the highways authority directly. The highways authority is good about communication and acknowledging complaints. You will also be able to track the progress of your report online and you will be notified when the matter has been put right.
