- 023/19 The **Minutes** of the meeting held on the 8th April 2019 were agreed as a true record.
- 024/19 **Planning YDNP E/03/36**, Crosby Ravensworth C of E School, Crosby Ravensworth. Full planning permission for erection of octagonal cedar wood bandstand for use as an outdoor covered teaching area and meeting area for the children. This had previously been discussed as a possible funding prospect and was fully supported.
- 025/19 **Planning YDNP E/03/35**, Oddendale Cottage, Oddendale, Shap Full planning permission for installation of sewage treatment plant. Supported.
- 026/19 **Planning EDC 19/0139**, Site address: COPPER BEECH LODGE SHAP PENRITH CA10 3QX Description: Variation of condition 2 (plans compliance) in respect of the design and size of the stable block attached to approval 18/0816.
This application had been considered at the council's meeting on the 8th April (165/18). At that time the council had objected on the basis that the proposal was not adequately described. There were proposed drawings. Units of measurement in the text were unknown so the size of the building was unclear and no dimension for height was given. The site was thought to be sensitive in terms of its height from the Queen's monument. It was agreed that the application should not have been validated. It had subsequently emerged that the correct plans had not been posted online by the planning authority and new plans were now available showing a building to which the council did not now object. A Councillor had visited the area and was satisfied that the structure would have no adverse impact on the setting of the Queen's monument. The application was supported and the previous objection withdrawn.
- 027/19 **Planning EDC 19/0294**, Site address: LAND BETWEEN FERN BANK & EAST VIEW REAGILL PENRITH CA10 3ER Description: Discharge of condition 7 (archaeological assessment and survey) attached to approval 18/0238. The assessment was noted to be astonishingly thorough! The application was supported.
